

# Instructions for the Authors

## 1. Submission of the paper

Authors who wish to have papers published in the Theoret.Appl.Mech. should send two copies of the manuscript (Format A4) including text, tables and figures on enclosed CD to the Chief Editor (for address see the inside cover page). The typesetting system should be LaTeX either by MikTeX or SCIENTIFIC WORD, preferable style is Standard LaTeX Article. Papers written by means of Microsoft Word are acceptable too but preferable system is LaTeX. The faster and better way to submit articles would be by electronic mail as attachment on the following addresses: either [mmicun@sezampro.rs](mailto:mmicun@sezampro.rs) or [mmicun@kg.ac.rs](mailto:mmicun@kg.ac.rs).

In both cases, for a fast communication and reducing waiting time it is absolutely necessary to send an e-mail address of the author(s) to the Chief Editor.

## 2. Preparation of the manuscript

**General:** The manuscripts should be in English and typed with double spacing on a single side of an A4 paper. The first page should contain: (1) short title, (2) all the names of the author(s), (3) an abstract of approximately 100 words, (4) keywords, (5) key-subjects of the paper according to the MSC2010 classification on [www.zentralblatt-math.org/msc/data/msc2010.pdf](http://www.zentralblatt-math.org/msc/data/msc2010.pdf). The paper should be concluded by proper conclusions, which reflect the findings in the paper. The editor will provide an abstract in Serbian language for each paper. The authors are responsible for proper spelling, punctuation and grammar. At the end of the paper the authors should provide names and addresses, *together with their e-mail addresses*, for correspondence.

**Tables and figures:** Tables and figures (both without captions) should be submitted either on enclosed diskettes or by electronic mail. Preferred format of figures is EPS. They should be referred in the text as Fig.1, Table 2, etc. A separate list of captions for both illustrations should be provided at the end of the manuscript.
